Natural selection can never afford to relax. We will see it at work in its struggle against malaria, the greatest killers of children in the world. Malaria is caused by a single-celled parasite that is transmitted to humans by mosquitoes. The parasite multiplies within both man and mosquito, and is highly infectious. The disease needs a fairly dense population to keep going.

The DNA of the most virulent malaria parasite is similar to that of one that infects birds; and this may have been where the disease came from. Malaria has spread all over the world wherever there are wet places for the mosquitoes to breed.

The malaria parasite does much of its damage by breaking in to blood cells and digesting them. Once the parasites get into the red cells there are other genetic ways of attacking them. Around the Mediterranean and in the Middle East there is a mutation that reduces the activity of an enzyme inside the cells. This reduces their ability to survive when a parasite gets in, and the cells die, taking the parasites with them.

The most widespread trick that evolution has come up with in its battle against malaria involves changes to the red-blood pigment, haemoglobin. In some places in West Africa, up to a third of children carry one or two copies of a gene for an altered haemoglobin known as sickle cells. When a cell from someone carrying this gene is attacked by a parasite, the hemoglobin forms fibers and the cell collapses, slowing the growth of the parasite.

In India and the Middle East there are mutations that act in much the same way - the suicide of cells invaded by the malaria parasite.

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
